**MORRISON GOVERNMENT DELIVERS \$300,000 FOR  
UPGRADES TO ARMADALE ROWING FACILITY**

The Rowing WA Champion Lakes Boating Club will undergo a massive upgrade thanks to \$300,000 in funding from the Morrison Government.

Based at Champion Lakes Regatta Centre, the funding will go towards building a new shed, allowing more boats and equipment to be stored on-site.

WA Liberal Senator Linda Reynolds said the Morrison Government is committed to supporting local sporting clubs.

“The Morrison Government recognises the wider health, social and community benefits that come from greater activity and participating in sport,” Senator Reynolds said.

“That is why we are upgrading facilities and infrastructure at sporting clubs across Australia through the Community Sport Infrastructure Grant program.

“I am delighted even more students in Perth’s south-east will now have the opportunity to engage in the program and be given the chance to learn a new skill.
